

HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE



• **Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday)**

April 16, 2011

Saturday 4:30 PM (English Language), 6:30 PM (Polish Language)

April 17, 2011

Sunday 7 AM (English Language), 9 AM (English Language),
11 AM (English Language) 1 PM (Polish Language).

The blessing and distribution of palms takes place outside of church with a procession to the Church in remembrance of Jesus' procession into Jerusalem. Weather may not permit an outside service.

The Easter Triduum

(Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday)

Lent ends at the beginning of the Holy Thursday Evening Mass. The Liturgical Season of Holy Triduum (Sacred Three Days) begins then: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

• **Holy Thursday The Mass of the Lord's Supper**



April 21, 2011 at 7:30 PM

This Mass is celebrated with our English, Filipino and Polish Communities.

After Communion, the Eucharist is taken in procession to the repository in the Chapel and Adoration begins. Below is a suggested Adoration schedule according to last names of families:

*9:00 PM (P thru S), 9:30 PM (L thru O), 10:00 PM (T thru Z),
10:30 PM (E thru G), 11:00 PM (A thru G), 11:30 PM (H thru K)*

Our Adoration ends at Midnight. Vigiling or "Keeping Watch" is a long tradition within the Church. We ask people to continue to wait in the empty Church in prayer throughout the day and night from Friday at Midnight until Saturday at noon. Sign up in Bethany Lobby for a time to join our vigil.



• **Good Friday The Service of the Lord's Passion**

April 22, 2011

12 Noon (English), 5:30 PM (Polish) and at 7:30 PM (English)

It is a service of scripture, prayer, adoration and Holy Communion.

Today is a day of fast (total of only two meals and no snacking) **and abstinence** (no meat).

Blessing of Food (English and Polish) at 12:30 PM and 2:30 PM (in Polish)

The Easter Vigil Masses

(THERE ARE NO REGULAR 4:30 PM OR 6:30 PM MASSES)

- Polish Vigil Mass at 5:00 PM
- English Vigil Mass at 8:00 PM



During the Vigil Mass, there are the baptisms and the reception of the elect and candidates into the Easter Mysteries. Following the Mass, there is a welcoming reception for those receiving the Easter Sacraments, and the "breaking of the Lenten / Triduum fast" with refreshment in Bethany Lobby.
