Curriculum

We believe all children are unique and learn at their own rate. We provide a loving, caring, and spiritual environment that respects individuality. Our program is play based as young children learn best through play and hands on exploration. The day features interest centers that include blocks, dramatic play, language development, math and manipulatives, expressive arts, and science. Our three year old program is designed to foster social growth, life skills, and features weekly learning themes. Our four year old and pre-kindergarten programs also incorporate kindergarten readiness skills including early reading and math skills. Our curriculum also includes the Jolly Phonics program, weekly music with our music teacher and play large motor games in the school gym.
