# HAVING FUN WITH FAITH

**Bisita Iglesia ● Church Visit - Thursday, April 5, 2012**



All high school youth (as well as Jr. High youth with families) are invited to carry out an ancient tradition known as “Church Visits” on Holy Thursday. We will attempt to visit seven different churches, praying a few Stations of the Cross in each church as a pilgrimage, during the hours of Adoration (between 8 p.m. and 12 midnight, after the Mass of the Last Supper). This tradition is a representation of keeping vigil with our Lord as He asked his disciples to do the night before he was crucified. Jesus asked His disciples to stay with Him, watch, and pray, which is what we will do during this pilgrimage. A permission slip is required for this event.

Mass at 7 p.m. then meet at the Youth Ministry room. All families are welcome to attend.

## Confirmation and Confirmation Rally

We will be taking registration for the Confirmation Formation process all summer long. All current 8th graders as well as any high school student who has not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation are encouraged to participate in the Confirmation Formation Process at St. Margaret Mary. Our program consists of six two-hour sessions which must be attended by both the Confirmation student and a sponsor.

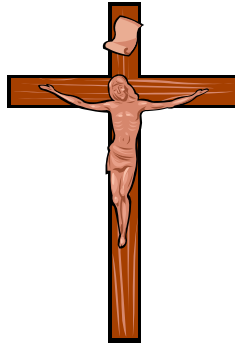

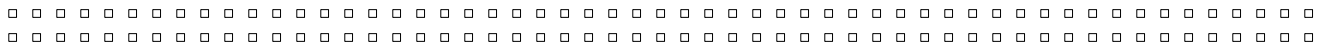


# Relay for Life

- Donations: Consider purchasing a box of food for \$35. *Any* donation will make a big difference to a starving child. At 15 cents per meal, we need to raise **\$6 million** for this year's expenses.
